D.S.O - Medal Awards:

1st World War – 2nd Lieutenants



Distinguished Service Order – D.S.O

Instituted by Queen Victoria 6th September 1886, as a Naval and Military Order of Distinction. Designated the Distinguished Service Order, for the purpose of rewarding individual instances of meritorious or distinguished service, by officers of the armed forces in wartime.

Ribbon: Red with Blue edges



2nd Lieutenant: Geoffrey Simpson, **Lamont** D.S.O, 1st Battalion Grenadier Guards. Died 5th November 1918, Aged 19. Son of John and Edith Catherine Lamont, of Hampstead, London. At Rest: Villers-Pol Communal Cemetery Extension, Nord, France. Buried: Row D, Grave 1.
