D.S.O - Medal Awards:

1st World War – Captains



Distinguished Service Order – D.S.O

Instituted by Queen Victoria 6th September 1886, as a Naval and Military Order of Distinction. Designated the Distinguished Service Order, for the purpose of rewarding individual instances of meritorious or distinguished service, by officers of the armed forces in wartime.

Ribbon: Red with Blue edges



Captain: Alwyn Bertram Robert R. **Gosselin**, D.S.O, 2nd Battalion Grenadier Guards. Died 7th February 1915. Aged 31. Son of Sir Martin Gosselin, G.C.V.O., K.C.M.G., C.B., and the Hon. Lady Gosselin, of Mayfair, London. At Rest: Cuinchy Communal Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France. Buried: Plot II, Row D, Grave 23.
