M.C - Medal Awards:

1st World War – Lieutenant Colonels



Military Cross – M.C

Instituted by King George the Fifth 28th December 1914. The Military Cross is awarded to commissioned and warrant officers for distinguished and meritorious service in battle. For additional acts of bravery, a straight silver bar was awarded. During the Great War 2,885 of these medals were awarded to British officers.

Ribbon: White with Purple central stripe



Lieutenant Colonel: G. E. Hope, M C, Grenadier Guards attached to 1st/8th Battalion Lancashire Fusiliers. Died 10th October 1917. At Rest: Ramscappelle Road Military Cemetery, Nieuwpoort, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium.
Buried: Plot VI, Row A, Grave 1.
