Said to be "Last seen waving his stick - Leading his men". 9th Duke of Northumberland. Parliamentary Private Secretary to the Lord Privy Seal, 1935. Son of the late Alan Ian Percy, K.G., C.B.E., M.V.O., 8th Duke of Northumberland, and of Helen Magdalene, Duchess of Northumberland. Buried in Plot IV, Row B, Grave 7

Son of Ebenezer John Lecky Pike and Olive Constance Pike, of Arundel, Sussex. Buried in Plot 43, Row A, Grave 7
Pilcher	J.A.	6464976	Officer Cadet	Grenadier Guards	-	-	29-Jan-1941	20	Selworthy (All Saints) Churchyard Extension, Somerset	Son of the Honourable Sir Gonne St. Clair Pilcher, M.C., and of Lady Pilcher (nee Hughes), of Lynch, Allerford, Somerset. Buried in Churchyard
Pritchard	H.E.	138606	Lieutenant	2nd	K.A.S	Warminster	11-Mar-1943	23	Wandsworth (Putney Vale) Cemetery, London	Believed killed when his tank overturned down railway embankment. Son of Edwin Alfred Pritchard, and of Elizabeth Esther Pritchard, of Buxted, Sussex, Grandson of Mrs. A. M. Pritchard. Buried in Block H, Grave 81
